COOKIES

This cookie notice applies to the website "knorr-bremse.com" (hereinafter referred to as "the/our website") and contains information regarding the types of cookies used on our website and how you can opt out of cookies, if you wish.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored in the browser of your device. We use cookies to provide you with the functions of our website and to tailor our website to your interests.

A distinction is made between cookies originating from Knorr-Bremse AG ("Knorr-Bremse"), known as "first-party cookies" - and cookies from other parties, known as "third-party cookies".

Cookies can be divided into four categories, depending on their function and intended use: strictly necessary cookies, functionality cookies, performance cookies and marketing cookies.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential to navigate around a website and use its features. Without these cookies, it may not be possible to correctly provide the services you request via the website. According to the applicable law, user consent is not required for strictly necessary cookies. Of course, you can configure your browser to block even strictly necessary cookies. However, in this case you may not be able to use the website in the intended manner. Should the data processed by strictly necessary cookies be deemed personal data in some specific cases, the legal basis for processing this data is the legitimate interest of Knorr-Bremse in the operation of the website.
